## The National Lottery

### Rules for Scratch Card Game “Bingo 90”

#### A. GENERAL

- 1) These are the Scratch Card Game Specific Rules for the Game called “Bingo 90” (hereinafter known as the “**Specific Rules**”) which will be operated by the National Lottery.
- 2) The Scratch Card Game General Rules contain the general rules which apply to all Scratch Card Games. For further information, please click [here](#). Additionally, both sets of rules can be obtained from Lottery Headquarters.
- 3) When you play “Bingo 90”, these Specific Rules and the Scratch Card Game General Rules apply. If there is any conflict or inconsistency between these Specific Rules and the Scratch Card Game General Rules these Specific Rules will prevail (unless the Company states otherwise).
- 4) The Game will commence on a date to be announced and will continue until the Game End Date.
- 5) These Specific Rules have been approved by the Regulator in accordance with Section 45 of the Act.

- 8) Where the context so requires, in these Specific Rules, the neutral gender shall include the feminine or masculine gender and vice versa, the feminine gender shall include the masculine gender and vice-versa and the singular shall include the plural and vice-versa.
- 9) Capitalised words and expressions defined in the Scratch Card Game General Rules but not herein shall have the same meanings as those set out in the Scratch Card Game General Rules when used herein.

#### B. DEFINITIONS

The following words and terms will have the following meanings unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 1) **Instant Prize** means the prize that is won when;
  - a) In any one of the Play Areas (Card 1, Card 2, Card 3, Card 4, Card 5, or Card 6) the numbers on one, two or three horizontal lines match numbers revealed in the CALLER’S CARD NUMBERS and BONUS NUMBERS Play Area on the left-hand side of the Ticket.

- b) Three matching symbols are revealed in the FAST €25 Play Area on the left-hand side of the Ticket.
- 2) **Play Symbols** mean the numbers and symbols which appear in the Play Area. The CALLERS CARD NUMBERS Play Area will contain thirty-two numbers from the range 1 to 90. The BONUS NUMBERS Play Area will contain eight numbers from the range 1 to 90. The FAST €25 Play Area will contain three symbols from the following set:



- 3) **Prize Percentage** means the total value of all Instant Prizes that are available to win in the Game as a percentage of the value of all Tickets in the Game Ticket Price

### C. COST OF PLAY

- 1) The price of a “Bingo 90” Ticket will be €4.

### D. HOW TO PLAY “BINGO 90”

- 1) There are three ways of winning on each ‘CARD’ on a National Lottery “Bingo 90” Ticket:

#### Win Type 1

Match five numbers in any one horizontal line on an individual ‘CARD’ corresponding with ‘CALLER’S CARD’ and ‘BONUS NUMBERS’.

#### Win Type 2

Match ten numbers in any two horizontal lines on an individual ‘CARD’ corresponding with ‘CALLER’S CARD’ and ‘BONUS NUMBERS’.

#### Win Type 3

Match fifteen numbers in three horizontal lines to create a FULL HOUSE on an individual ‘CARD’ corresponding with ‘CALLER’S CARD’ and ‘BONUS NUMBERS’.

The Instant Prize applicable to each win type is as follows:

Win Type	Card 1	Card 2	Card 3	Card 4	Card 5	Card 6
1 Line	€4	€8	€12	€15	€20	€40
2 Lines	€8	€12	€20	€20	€40	€100
FULLHOUSE	€100	€200	€400	€1,000	€2,000	€40,000

Players can win up to six times on the “Bingo 90” Ticket but can only win one Win Type on any of the six referenced CARD Play Areas on each Ticket, in which case the player shall be entitled to the sum of those Instant Prize amounts.

**FAST €25 Game**

If the owner of a Ticket reveals three of the same symbols in the FAST €25 Play Area he shall be entitled to an Instant Prize of €25.

## E. TICKET VALIDATION

- 1) To be a valid “Bingo 90” National Lottery Ticket in addition to the general conditions on Ticket validation set out in the Scratch Card Game General Rules ([click here](#)) the following specific conditions must be met:
- 2) Exactly thirty-two Play Symbols must appear in the CALLER’S CARD Play Area and eight Play Symbols must appear in the BONUS NUMBER Play Area and exactly fifteen Play Symbols must appear in each of the six CARD Play Area and three Play Symbols must appear in the FAST €25 Play Area of the Ticket.
- 3) Each of the Play Symbols and their correct captions must be present in their entirety, must be fully legible and must be printed in grey/black ink;
- 4) Each of the Play Symbols and its caption appearing on the Ticket must be printed in accordance with the official font schedule for “Bingo 90” as agreed between the Company and the Ticket manufacturer;
- 5) The Validation/Security Number must be printed in accordance with the official font schedule for “Bingo 90” as agreed between the Company and the Ticket manufacturer.
- 6) The Game/Book/Ticket Number must be printed in accordance with the official font schedule for “Bingo 90” as agreed between the Company and the Ticket manufacturer.

## G. PRIZE AMOUNTS, NUMBER OF PRIZES AND ODDS OF WINNING VARIOUS PRIZES

- 1) The prize table that is set out below provides details on the Instant Prizes that are available to win in “Bingo 90” and the odds of winning an Instant Prize.
- 2) At time of purchase some Instant Prizes may have already been won.
- 3) The figures below are based on a complete sale of all Tickets in the game. The Company may, at its discretion, extend the scale of a game by putting on sale a full reprint of the game or a larger or smaller version in direct proportion to the structure set out in the table below:
