Rules for Interactive Instant Win Game "Cash Bonanza"

A. GENERAL

- These are the Interactive Instant Win Game Specific Rules for the Game called "Cash Bonanza" (hereinafter known as the "Specific Rules") which will be operated by the National Lottery.
- 2) The General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games contain the general rules which apply to all Interactive Instant Win Games. For further information, please click <u>here</u>. Additionally, both sets of rules can be obtained from Lottery Headquarters.
- 3) When you play "Cash Bonanza", these Specific Rules, the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games, the Account Terms and the Data Privacy Statement apply. If there is any conflict or inconsistency between these Specific Rules and the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games, these Specific Rules will prevail (unless the Company states otherwise).
- 4) The Game will commence on the date it is made available on the Interactive Channels and will remain available until such time as it is removed from the Interactive Channels. The Company reserves the right to recommence the Game at any time and for such duration as the Company decides at its sole discretion.
- 5) These Specific Rules have been approved by the Regulator in accordance with Section 45 of the Act.

- 8) Where the context so requires, in these Specific Rules, the neutral gender shall include the feminine or masculine gender and vice versa, the feminine gender shall include the masculine gender and vice-versa and the singular shall include the plural and vice-versa.
- 9) Capitalised words and expressions defined in the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games or the Account Terms but not herein shall have the same meanings as those set out in the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games or the Account Terms when used herein.

B. COST OF PLAY

1) The price of a "Cash Bonanza" play will be €5.

C. HOW TO PLAY "CASH BONANZA"

- 1) To play "Cash Bonanza" the Player taps the "Play" link on the Game Play Window.
- 2) To advance the game, the Player taps "Play". The Game Play Window then displays:
 - Title: "YOUR NUMBERS"
 - Instruction: "SELECT 5 FROM 6".
 - Six (6) '2' symbols



- 3) The Game's objective is to win Prize(s) by matching a 'GAME 1' number with a number in 'YOUR NUMBERS'; and/or by matching 2 numbers in any 'COLUMN' with any numbers in 'YOUR NUMBERS' in 'GAME 2'; and/or by matching 3 numbers in any 'ROW' with any numbers in 'YOUR NUMBERS' in 'GAME 3'.
- 4) The Player taps five (5) of the six (6) ''s symbols to reveal the 'YOUR NUMBERS' for the game and the window transitions to 'GAME 1'.
- 5) In 'GAME 1' the Player must tap on each one of fifteen (15) ' symbols to reveal a number and corresponding prize amount. If any revealed number matches any number from 'YOUR NUMBERS' the corresponding 'PRIZE' is won.



- 6) Once 'GAME 1' is completed a message prompts the Player to tap the arrow to transition to 'GAME 2'.
- 7) In 'GAME 2', the Player must tap on each of the twelve (12) 'symbols to reveal a number and a corresponding prize amount for each 'COLUMN'. If both revealed numbers in a 'COLUMN' match any two numbers from 'YOUR NUMBERS' the corresponding 'PRIZE' for that 'COLUMN' is won.



- 8) Once 'GAME 2' is completed a message prompts the Player to tap the arrow to transition to 'GAME 3'.
- 9) In 'GAME 3' the Player must tap on each one of the twelve (12) ' a' symbols to reveal a number and a corresponding prize amount for each 'ROW'. If all three revealed numbers in a 'ROW' match any three numbers from 'YOUR NUMBERS' the corresponding 'PRIZE' for that 'ROW' is won.



- 10)Once 'GAME 3' is completed a message prompts the Player to tap the arrow to transition to the 'BONUS GAME'.
- 11)In the 'BONUS GAME' the player must tap one (1) of the three (3) ' symbols to reveal a bonus 'YOUR NUMBER'



- 12) The Player is then prompted to tap the button to check all games for new matches. The game then automatically goes through each of the game screens checking for any numbers in each game that match with the bonus number added to 'YOUR NUMBERS'.
- 13) When play has completed, the result displays on the Game Play Window:

- 14) The Player taps 'FINISH' to accept the result.
- 15) The Game concludes and the result is displayed.

E. PRIZE AMOUNTS, NUMBER OF PRIZES AND ODDS OF WINNING VARIOUS PRIZES

- 1) The prize table that is set out below provides details on the Prizes that are available to win in "Cash Bonanza" and the odds of winning same.
- 2) The determination of whether or not a Player has won a Prize (and the level of any such Prize) is randomly determined by the Central Gaming System at the point of purchase of the Play.
- 3) Game sounds, animation and Player interfaces are solely for entertainment purposes and do not impact on the outcome of the Game.
