## The National Lottery

### Rules for Interactive Instant Win Game “Digital Champions”

#### A. GENERAL

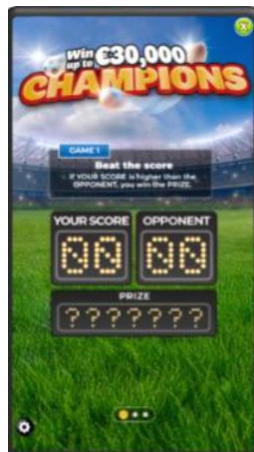
- 1) These are the Interactive Instant Win Game Specific Rules for the Game called “Digital Champions” (hereinafter known as the “Specific Rules”) which will be operated by the National Lottery.
- 2) The General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games contain the general rules which apply to all Interactive Instant Win Games. For further information, please click [here](#). Additionally, both sets of rules can be obtained from Lottery Headquarters.
- 3) When you play “Digital Champions”, these Specific Rules, the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games, the Account Terms and the Data Privacy Statement apply. If there is any conflict or inconsistency between these Specific Rules and the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games, these Specific Rules will prevail (unless the Company states otherwise).
- 4) The Game will commence on the date it is made available on the Interactive Channels and will remain available until such time as it is removed from the Interactive Channels. The Company reserves the right to recommence the Game at any time and for such duration as the Company decides at its sole discretion.
- 5) These Specific Rules have been approved by the Regulator in accordance with Section 45 of the Act.

- 8) Where the context so requires, in these Specific Rules, the neutral gender shall include the feminine or masculine gender and vice versa, the feminine gender shall include the masculine gender and vice-versa and the singular shall include the plural and vice-versa.
- 9) Capitalised words and expressions defined in the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games or the Account Terms but not herein shall have the same meanings as those set out in the General Rules for Account Management and Interactive Instant Win Games or the Account Terms when used herein.

## B. COST OF PLAY

- 1) The price of a “Digital Champions” play will be €3.

## C. HOW TO PLAY “DIGITAL CHAMPIONS”

- 1) To play “Digital Champions” the Player taps the “Play” link on the Game Play Window.
- 2) To advance the game, the Player taps “Play”. The Game Play Window then displays:
  - ‘GAME 1’ containing two (2) score boards, one labelled ‘YOUR SCORE’ and another labelled ‘OPPONENT’.
  - The prize panel for Game 1.
  - Game instruction: “Beat the Score: If YOUR SCORE is higher than the OPPONENT, you win the prize”.



- 3) The Game’s objective is to win Prize(s) by revealing a higher score in ‘YOUR SCORE’ than in ‘OPPONENT’ in ‘GAME 1’ and/or revealing one or more WINNING SYMBOLS(s) in ‘GAME 2’ and/or revealing three (3) like amounts in ‘GAME 3’.
- 4) In ‘GAME 1’, the Player must tap on ‘YOUR SCORE’ and ‘OPPONENT’ to reveal the scores. The player must tap on ‘PRIZE’ to reveal any prize amount.
- 5) If ‘YOUR SCORE’ revealed is higher than the ‘OPPONENT’ the Player wins the ‘PRIZE’.
- 6) Once ‘GAME 1’ is completed ‘GAME 2’ is displayed.
- 7) In ‘GAME 2’ the Player must tap on the big cup to reveal eight (8) smaller cups. The Player taps each of the cups and reveals symbols.
- 8) If any of the symbols revealed match any of the ‘WINNING SYMBOLS’ the Player wins the associated prize(s).

- 9) Once 'GAME 2' is completed 'GAME 3' is displayed.
- 10) In 'GAME 3' the Player must tap on each of the eight (8) ball symbols to reveal eight (8) prize amounts.
- 11) If three matching amounts are revealed the Player wins the matched amount.
- 12) When play has completed, the result displays on the Game Play Window:

- 13) The Player taps 'FINISH' to accept the result.
- 14) The Game concludes and the result is displayed.

## **E. PRIZE AMOUNTS, NUMBER OF PRIZES AND ODDS OF WINNING VARIOUS PRIZES**

- 1) The prize table that is set out below provides details on the Prizes that are available to win in "Digital Champions" and the odds of winning same.
- 2) The determination of whether or not a Player has won a Prize (and the level of any such Prize) is randomly determined by the Central Gaming System at the point of purchase of the Play.
- 3) Game sounds, animation and Player interfaces are solely for entertainment purposes and do not impact on the outcome of the Game.
